Arthur and I recently shared a [note](#) about the values of The Times with links to resources to use if you experience or witness harassment or any other interaction that contradicts or falls short of those values. Beginning this month and continuing on an ongoing basis, we will introduce online and in-person training for employees at every level to reinforce our standards for civility in our workplace. Civility and appropriate conduct means demonstrating positive behaviors and knowing how to recognize and respond appropriately to unwelcome conduct.
