Some researchers conclude that little difference exists between men and women in terms of [sexual behavior](#).^{[221][222]} Other researchers disagree.^[223] [Symmetrical](#) men and women have a tendency to begin to have [sexual intercourse](#) at an earlier age, to have more sexual partners, to engage in a wider variety of [sexual activities](#), and to have more [one-night stands](#).
