



Search, share & more

Charms make everyday things like searching and sharing easy. To see them, swipe in from the right or point your mouse to the upper-right corner, then move it down.

Search – Search for something specific within an app or across your PC

Share – Share files and info with friends without leaving the app you're in

Start – Go back to the Start screen anytime

Devices – See and use the devices connected to your PC, like a printer or TV

Settings – Find information, help, and settings for your PC and the app you're in

Getting around

Now more of your screen is available for the content you want. To see the commands for the app you're in, swipe up from the bottom edge (or down from the top) or right-click within the app.

To switch between apps, swipe in from the left edge or point your mouse to the upper-left corner and click the app that appears.

If you want to close an app, drag it with your finger or mouse from the top to the bottom of the screen.

Do two things at once


Do two things at once

Get more done in Windows when you use two apps at the same time.

On a touchscreen, swipe in from the left edge to bring in a second app, then drag it to the left or right side of the screen.

With a mouse, point to the upper-left corner until the second app appears. Once you see it, drag it to the left or right side of the screen.
