Good Afternoon Heather,

Per the customer request on the slight tone difference in the veneer samples here are a few variables that could be the difference

- Ø Outside vendor uses a different finish product.
- Ø Different run in the veneer ( variation in the same log )
- Ø Exposure to light

Ø In my opinion we do not want to tone our sample as it would take away from the natural characteristics of the veneer and make it mono tone.

Ø The color between the samples now is so close and at some angles identical. ( again toning would remove the color change effect that this veneer has when finished natural )
