**PLAINTIFFS JANE DOES' 2- 7 REQUEST FOR EMERGENCY HEARING  
ON PLAINTIFFS' PENDING MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Plaintiffs, Jane Does 2-7, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby file this Request for Emergency Hearing on Plaintiffs' Motion for Protective Order, pursuant to S.D.Fla.L.R. 7.1(E), and state as follows:

1. Plaintiffs Jane Does 2-7 filed a Motion for Protective Order on July 29, 2009 (DE 226). That Motion concerns the acts and conduct of Defendant Epstein's investigators in interviewing nonparties.

2. Since the filing of Plaintiffs' Motion, Defendant's investigators have continued aggressively to contact nonparties seeking extensive personal information about the Plaintiffs. In

doing so, the Plaintiffs' anonymity is being seriously and unnecessarily compromised. The acts and conduct of the investigators are intimidating the Plaintiffs. Filed simultaneously herewith is the Declaration of Jane Doe No. 7 in further support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Protective Order, which specifically describes the conduct of one of Defendant's investigators.

3. Under the circumstances, immediate relief is necessary to protect the Plaintiffs' anonymity.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the time requirements of S.D.Fla.L.R. 7.1 be waived and that an immediate hearing be scheduled on Plaintiffs' Motion for Protective Order.
