[REDACTED] SAID THAT ONCE INSIDE THE HOTEL ROOM WITH [REDACTED] SHE WAS UNSURE OF WHETHER SHE WAS SAFE BECAUSE ALTHOUGH SHE WANTED TO LAND THE JOB AS A MODEL IN VICTORIA'S SECRET CATALOG, SHE FELT AS THOUGH [REDACTED] WAS ATTEMPTING TO GET HER TO ACT IN AN UNPROFESSIONAL MANNER FOR A MODEL.
