Re: Rescheduling November Origins meeting in St. Thomas

I am very sorry to report that we have been forced to reschedule our Nov 12-15th Origins science advisory meeting in St. Thomas. While we do so reluctantly, and recognize the inconvenience to many of you, two factors compelled us to make this decision. First, detailed scheduling arrangements on-site in St. Thomas became confused enough that our sponsor was worried about our ability to hold a successful meeting at the Ritz Carlton hotel at this time. Second, and perhaps more important was the fact that enough of our scheduled attendees had to change their plans at the last minute due to scheduling conflicts that we felt we would not have significant enough representation from our valued board to justify holding the meeting at this time.
