When we had the conversation of the cost of the airplane hanger and I told you the slab would cost \$350,000 and you questioned the cost of concrete, I said \$300 to \$400 a yard. The rule of thumb is concrete in place is about double the cost of the cost of just the concrete; ie steel, forms, placement and finish.

Apples to apples, our cost to produce 4,000# concrete is \$164.17 vs. St Thomas concrete at \$188.50. And if we use our produced stone our cost is \$131.57 (roads only)
