The numbers can be black, but must have a highlighting boarder that makes them stand out, since you are selcting a dark charcoal color exterior.

choice combo:

we could have a black number with a tan border line N908GM,

we could have a black number with a silver boarder.

just a solid or hollow silver number.

I don't think the FAA will buy off on an N Number with a color that matches the seat fabric, It is pretty dark, I believe would boarder it with sliver, tan or White (shadow it maybe?)

during certification, the N Numbeerr contrast must be able to be read 500 feet away, (this is what Sirkorksy is telling me, Min size is 12 inch letters I know for a fact, plus there is a contrast "minimum" like 60%... I will look up in regs. for exact numbers.
