Jeffrey,

After reviewing with Karen, I was made aware that your closet storage in the Master Suite has been insufficient with the existing layout.

Working with the Pinto layout I would like to propose the following revisions as shown in the attached option D:

- A spacious Dressing Room with built in cabinets and twice the amount (or more if required) of storage than the Pinto layout which matches what exists now
- Convert Vestibule that led to Steam Shower into Toilet Room (we can work in a small sink if you wish)
- Single entry into Steam Room through Shower.

For comparison, [REDACTED] has taken photos of your existing Dressing Rm and will review them with you at your meeting.

Option D will give you more storage and make the Dressing area for gracious. The only option you lose is the double entry into the Steam Room.

Let me know what you think.
