Hope this finds you well.

Dr. Jarecki and Mr. Breyer recommended that I write to you directly in connection with Mr. Breyer's note about me, below. My name is Lou O'Neill and I worked on the Obama campaign in six states over the course of a year, culminating in Virginia, where as Assistant to the State Leadership, I helped orchestrate our victory there.
