The following is a first draft of equipment list for the Little St. James screening room. This is a dynamic list in that it will change according to the custmers desire and needs. Please take a look and comment.

Projector:

Sony SXR4 4K projector model SRX-R220 (Brochure attached)

This projector is a 4K cinema projector capable of 3D content (with optional lens). The server is included with the unit installed in the base along with a UPS backup (the brochure indicates an LMT 100 server but the current is the new LMT 200)

Note: in case 3D is an option considered the screen would need to be a silver screen due to the fact that sony uses the Real D system. If 3D is not a consideration than instead of using model SRX-R220 a R210 model may be used (lower light output)
