Quick update this morning. I am also attaching a photo of Nancy with her neurologist who, like all neurologists, is German. His name, and I would never joke around about something like this if it weren't true, is Axel Rose(ngart). I imagine she will appreciate my sparing you the view of the right side of her head, which looks like a well-stitched softball.

Axel Rose says that Nancy is doing extremely well today. I already knew that because she was funnier and more lucid than ever.

They were scheduled to do an angiogram this [REDACTED] to determine whether and the extent to which she is experiencing vasospasm (reduced bloodflow flow to the brain as a result of the leaked blood irritating the outside of the blood vessels). But when the neurologist saw Nancy's improved condition this morning he said they would push back the angiogram a couple of days and just do a simpler CT scan today.

So while vasospasm still poses a significant risk, and there are a few others as well, Nancy is showing pretty amazing improvement.
