Pursuant to our discussion, [REDACTED] wishes to retain my law firm. For your client's review, we bill as follows per attorney and paralegal hour:

In so much as this case involves potentially a significant amount of attorney time, I request a twenty five thousand dollar (\$25,000.00) retainer, which we would put in my Client's Trust Account, as we bill against it which will reduce the retainer and the amount is expected to be replenished within fifteen (15) days of billing.
