As you already know, the opinion polls that the public and rest of the world so heavily relied upon regarding Brexit proved to be wrong. I took your advice and used my sentiment analysis and opinion mining system to predict the outcome of this major political event so that we can help investors make sound investment decisions. We analyzed opinions, sentiments and emotions of people on twitter. We conducted sentiment analysis of more than half a million tweets before referendum day. 51% tweets supported leaving EU and only 27% tweeted about remaining. Out of 327K tweets collected on day of referendum, 167K showed support for Brexit, 103K tweets were about people showing their support to remain in the EU and remaining tweets were neutral.
