I wanted to very, very kindly follow up on my previous emails concerning my start-up in Nigeria. I have attached our financial projections and a brief presentation. I am currently seeking USD560K in seed investment (in exchange for equity). I will work (very hard) to try to close a round before I move to Lagos in July.

Recruitment challenges in Africa – most of them stemming from problems in educational systems – are many. The opportunities to capitalize on these challenges are many. Our revenue model draws on Andela and Code Academy's revenue logics.
