Dear [REDACTED]:

Hello, how are you? I hope you are having a very nice end of the week.

I'm David Lopez, and I'm a journalist from Madrid, Spain, contributor of the spanish edition of Vanity Fair. I know I'm not the first journalist reaching you these days, but i've been waiting a few days to write you, hoping that you don't feel very invade because of this message. I'm writing you to ask you for your kind help. I've been asked to write a long feature for Vanity Fair about what is happening with the Epstein case but specially focused in prince Andrew of UK, and I'm writing you to ask you for your help for it.

I know other colleagues have been asking you for interviews, but I also would like to do it. I guess you probably don't want to do it, but I would like to ask you in case you could be considering maybe doing just one interview to stop other interview requests. In case that could be your position, I would be glad if you could consider doing it with Vanity Fair. But, of course, I would be glad to discuss and talk any doubt you could have, by email or by phone, and of course with absolute discretion, even in case you finally could reject the proposal.

And if not, if you don't want to do it, something I of course absolutely respect, I would like to ask you for your help, asking you if you could help me off the record, with the guarantee that nobody could know that have talked and not publishing your name in my story. I know and understand you don't know me, so you can't trust of me. The only thing I can tell you is that I'm a very serious journalist and fair, and that I would ever do anything to damage you. I've done a large number of stories, that you can find googling my name and the story, with a large number of relevant people, from the Dalai Lama, to infamous murderer Charles Manson, who granted me an interview four years ago.

Of course, I would also be glad to send you as further details about me or my work as you could need, as well as any prove could make you trust on me if you could talk with me. I hope you could consider this request, but let me thank you in advance at least your time reading my message.
