A couple of things I forgot to mention:

1. I want to confirm that the 1/2 dozen or so intra family notes that compound annually should be amended to annual cash pay. I also want to confirm that you want the interest rates somewhat higher than the AFR safe harbor rates.
 2. I plan to institute quarterly meetings between the Trustees and beneficiaries where they will be provided (by the trustees) a quarterly update on the trust assets. This will also be a forum for general discussion between trustees and beneficiaries.
