This is a rough outline which I will tidy & firm up once you review the door & 1/2 door suggestions

Based on your direction TV at Zorro is on a chest, not wall mounted, but clearly can be wall mounted

The wall between the 2 operational breezeway doors is only big enough for a small love seat hence moved large sofa forward with sofa table or storage unit as an anchor, possible lamp placement area

Clearly chairs & ottomans can be moved.

Once you have confirmed door & wall I can forward a number of other furniture placement recommendations
