I have jokingly suggested to my husband that I should go to Southpoint and hold up a sign showing my support for Dr. Krauss. My initial suggestion for the sign was 'Child Molestation Victims for Krauss'. I'm certain that would grab people's attention. I decided that 'Don't Grouse About Krauss' has a better ring.

Of course, nobody is interested in listening to the opinion of a poorly educated, lowly housewife with quite severe dyslexia like me, when they can be listening to Rebecca Watson. Still, I thought, perhaps, I should provide Dr. Krauss with the opportunity to listen to my perspective if he would like. Because of my dyslexia, writing is difficult for me, (I have been working on this e-mail for over an hour) so oral communication would be better.
