He mentioned to the board members his intension's of opening an FBO and he stated, he's negotiating with Freedom Air the possibility of sub leasing from us. You where quit clear with Nicolas to hold off putting in his application for the FBO until we are awarded the hanger, however it didn't stop him verbalizing his intension's. Nicolas did not officially submit his application to port authority, only lobbied his case to the board today. I would assume there will be board members that will brief Hancock.
