I guess you still don't like the last paragraph with history.. which I promised people in my last public statement.. I think I have to add it. That seems to be the major difference between versions right now.

I think saying it is unamerican is a bit strong. Also we cannot say that is the rule. Under the Jeffrey dictum I have to be accurate... This is not the rule.. ABOR simply don't require it, and the University Office of Equity and investigation didn't allow it for whatever internal practices they follow.

One thing that is changed is replacing the bulky "Even after the conclusion of the investigation by the OEI (University's Office of Equity and Inclusion) as communicated by the University Provost to me," with "Based on what has been reported to me by the University"...

Now.. this is close, and I can wordsmith it on the plane or in the morning. I think the last sentence is not necessary.

I have 5 hours and 32 min to get the retirement letter in, and it is midnight here and I would like to try and get it sent off by 2 am so I can get a few hours sleep before heading to the airport at 730.. Nancy is working on the version I sent you both now.. Hopefully we can converge on that soon so I can send it off, and pack. Can you look at that? Much appreciated. If you would prefer to wait to see the version after her edits that is fine.. She is almost done I am told.

Yesterday I submitted and the University accepted my letter of retirement to be effective at the end of this academic year , May 16, 2019. . While the termination of The ASU Origins Project earlier this year made staying at ASU for the long term less attractive to me, my choice to retire at this time was dictated by the unamerican regulations of the Arizona Board of Regents. ie . I was not allowed at all to test the veracity of claims made by accusers unless I first agreed to be dismissed. That is the rule . To be clear

I have never harassed or assaulted anyone and have most certainly not exhibited gender bias in my professional dealings at the University or elsewhere. Even after the conclusion of the investigation by the OEI (University's Office of Equity and Inclusion) as communicated by the University Provost to me, none of my students, departmental staff, faculty colleagues, research colleagues and postdoctoral fellows, or participants in the Origins events I led over the past decade at ASU, has ever issued any allegations or complaints to the University regarding my behavior. I look forward to continuing my work and research , hopefully with a greater sensitivity to others.
