LSJ Banquette review as requested:

I will work up estimated cost to reupholster once I know whether or not two of the backrest pieces are to be rebuilt to make them higher.

That modification would require us to sculpt new foam pieces to accommodate the extra height.

I will need to go back to the Island to measure the new bed frames for the mosquito netting covers. That will have to wait another couple weeks or so.

On Dec 21st, I fractured the tibia and fibula in my lower left leg. I am in a non-weight bearing cast and am forced to get around with crutches on one leg.

Needless to say, I am not travelling very far these days.

Tuesday the 22nd is my next X-ray. I will have a much better concept of how much longer it will be before the cast is removed and physical therapy begins.

We do open our business whenever I can schedule smaller sized jobs that I am capable of doing in a short day's work.

Will get back to you again after Tuesday. In the meantime, please let me know whether or not modifications are to be made to the Banquette backrests.
