If they are not RVSM Certified when flying across the N. Atlantic they are allowed to fly above RVSM Altitudes ([FL290](#) - [FL410](#)) however upon entering the European FIR they will have to descend below RVSM Altitudes ([FL290](#)). Flight above RVSM altitudes for an aircraft that is Non-RVSM compliant is not allowed.
