Dear Mr. Knight:

I have recently been contacted by [REDACTED] to represent her for damages she suffered as a result of her experience with Jeffrey Epstein in 2002. Similar to other victims of Jeffrey Epstein's abuse, she was brought to Mr. Epstein's house by [REDACTED] after being told that she would make money for giving an older wealthy man a massage.

When she first arrived at Mr. Epstein's house, she was greeted by [REDACTED] took [REDACTED] upstairs to Mr. Epstein's bathroom where the massage table was open and the lotions were out. After a few minutes, Mr. Epstein entered the room, disrobed, and lied down on the massage table face down. He instructed her to begin massaging him and engaged in small talk about what [REDACTED] planned to do after high school. During that conversation, Mr. Epstein talked to her about pursuing a career in massage therapy. After the massage, he paid [REDACTED] \$200 before she left.

The next day [REDACTED] was contacted by Mr. Epstein's butler who told her that Mr. Epstein wanted to send her a gift and needed her address to do so. The next day she received a package that included 2 books on massages and some massage oils. A couple days later, [REDACTED] was contacted by [REDACTED] who told her that Mr. Epstein wanted to schedule her to work at his house, which she understood meant to give him a massage. She drove to his house at

the arranged time and was again greeted by [REDACTED]. She was lead upstairs to the bathroom, and then Mr. Epstein walked in, undressed, and told her to wait while he took a shower.

Mr. Epstein got out of the shower and told [REDACTED] to take her top off. She replied that she did not feel comfortable doing that and Mr. Epstein then lied naked on the massage table and instructed [REDACTED] to begin massaging him. During the massage, Mr. Epstein told [REDACTED] to pinch his nipples as he began to masturbate in her presence. [REDACTED] was terrified from this point on and was just hoping to get out of his house alive and without being hurt. Mr. Epstein eventually ejaculated in her presence before paying [REDACTED] \$300. [REDACTED] believed that she was paid an extra \$100 because Mr. Epstein knew she was uncomfortable and this additional money was to remind her to be quiet about what occurred. [REDACTED] was called to return but did not.


This encounter with Mr. Epstein has caused [REDACTED] great emotional distress over the years, and she is finally able to come forward about this event. At this time, she is still willing to settle this case with Mr. Epstein without filing a lawsuit so long as he pays her an amount that represents fair compensation for the damage he caused.

We believe that a jury will return a seven figure verdict in this case if it were to go to trial. At this time, we demand \$200,000 tendered in within 20 days of the mailing of this demand (March 30, 2011).
