The lawyers who have sought to intervene in this case seek an extension of time until October 31, 2011 to file a reply to their supplemental briefing in support of their motion to intervene. As the Court knows, the issues that have been raised in these proceedings concerning Mr. Epstein's plea negotiations are significant and at times complicated. We have been working on the reply in support of Mr. Epstein's motion for limited intervention, which we filed today. [DE 108]. We respectfully request an additional 11 days to respond to the issues raised by the plaintiffs in their response to the lawyers' supplemental briefing.
