Students who have relatives or friends in the New York City metropolitan area willing to provide free room and board (housing, utilities, and food) must submit an ***Affidavit of Sponsor Providing Free Room & Board in the New York City Metropolitan Area*** with supporting financial documentation. Documentation showing that a student receives full room (housing) has a cash value of **\$16,344.00** for 12 months. These students or their sponsor must show an additional \$7,308.00 in funds to cover Board, Transportation, and Personal expenses.

Estimated expenses for your program should be calculated at an increase of approximately 4-6% for each succeeding year.

Students bringing dependents (spouse or children 21 years old or younger) in F-2 or J-2 status must each year show an added \$5,000.00 to support the first dependent, and \$4,000.00 for each additional dependent.
