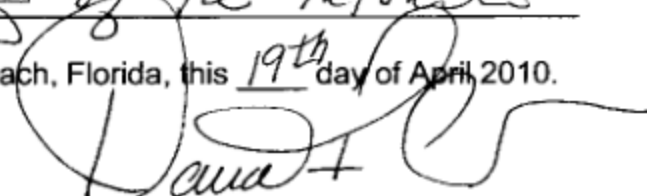

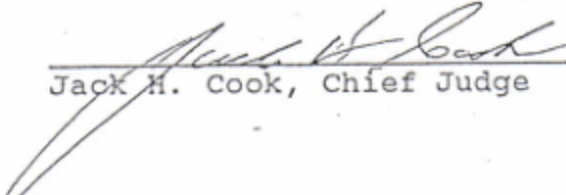
IN RE: MOTIONS TO SET CAUSE FOR TRIAL
