






AFFIDAVIT OF PAUL G. CASSELL

1. I am the Ronald N. Boyce Presidential Professor of Criminal Law at the S.J. Quinney College of Law at the University of Utah.
2. I graduated from Stanford Law School, where I served as President of the *Stanford Law Review*.
3. I clerked for then-Judge Antonin Scalia when Scalia was on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit and then for the Chief Justice of the United States, Warren Burger.
4. I then served as an Associate Deputy Attorney General with the U.S. Justice Department and as an Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Eastern District of Virginia.
5. I then joined the faculty at the College of Law, where I taught full time until I was sworn in as a U.S. District Court Judge for the District of Utah in 2002.
6. In 2007, I resigned my judgeship to return full time to the College of Law, to (among other things) teach, write, and litigate on issues relating to crime victims' rights.
7. I am a co-author of the law school casebook, *Victims in Criminal Procedure* (Carolina Academic Press 3d ed. 2010).
8. I have handled pro bono numerous Crime Victims' Rights Act cases in district and appellate courts across the country, including a recent pro bono case he argued to the U.S. Supreme Court for a crime victim (*Paroline v. U.S.*).
9. I am currently a member in good standing of the bar of the State of Utah. I have handled and continue to handle legal cases on both a paid and pro bono basis in Utah and elsewhere.
