Thank you again for meeting to discuss the intercampus initiative - I'm attaching some papers on the octave illusion. Before talking with Diana, we might want to dissect, critique, and modify the psychophysical methods and independently corroborate the results before doing any brain measures. Measuring bold signal in the inferior colliculus and cochlear nucleus as well as Heschls and other cortical ROIs might be revealing given the multiple auditory brainstem commissures.

I discovered this week that the Special Olympics are in LA this July - not a hotel available in Covell or anywhere else in the city!
