Hi Larry,

On picture number 5927, from the front side of the seat back to the front edge of the arm rest is only 10 inches, and we need to shorten that about $\frac{3}{4}$ to 1" so it isn't taller than the back rests of the 2 seats when it is stowed. If we put a couple of telescoping glides on this, the arm rest would move forward approximately 2-2.5" so there is a bit more length on the arm rest. When it stows it would drop back down to the level of the 2 outside seat back tops.
