New Credit Suisse boss has plenty of challenges in his in-tray

Tidjane Thiam described [Credit Suisse](#) as “an exceptional business” with “a solid strategy and strong momentum” when the Prudential chief executive was [unveiled as the Swiss bank’s new boss](#) on Tuesday morning.

But once the 52-year-old takes over from Brady Dougan at Credit Suisse in June, he will face a string of challenges to reverse the relative underperformance of the bank in recent years. A 7 per cent jump in the lender’s shares on Tuesday shows that investors are optimistic he is up to the job. Here are the main issues awaiting Mr Thiam.
