## Flight to Andrew

Jeffrey Epstein took his teenage "sex slave" on a seven-day private-jet get-away before allegedly pimping her out to Prince Andrew in London in 2001, the Times of London reported on Wednesday.

Epstein picked up [redacted] in Palm Beach, Fla., with pal Ghislaine Maxwell — daughter of the disgraced late media mogul Robert Maxwell — before they jetted off to Canada and Paris, the paper reported.

Once in Paris, they rendezvoused with interior designer Alberto Pinto and his sister, Linda Pinto — before flying to Spain and London, where [redacted] claims in a lawsuit she was paid to bed Prince Andrew.

[redacted] — whom Epstein allegedly peddled for \$15,000 a night — was then taken to Maxwell's home Knightsbridge, where she met Prince Andrew, she claims. There, the royal was photographed with his arm around the teenager's bare stomach, according to [redacted]

The next night, the teen went to the nightclub Tramp in Mayfair before she was pressured into having sex with Prince Andrew, [redacted] claims.

Linda Pinto — who parted ways with Epstein and the teen before they landed in London — said she had no clue [redacted] was a minor, she said Wednesday.

"You did not know if they were 19, 22 or younger girls," she said of the girls who sometimes traveled with Epstein.

"I cannot say what they planned to do, but I never suspected anything. His actions never made me suspect him," she said on Wednesday.

Epstein's jet has been at the center of other lawsuits, including one alleging that he used the plane to transport women in an "expansive criminal enterprise that involved and depended upon his plane travel."

The former multimillionaire banker flew dozens of his well-heeled friends, including actors and politicians, such as Bill Clinton, all over the world on the jet.

Epstein, a registered sex offender, served 13 months in prison for soliciting an underage girl for prostitution in 2008. He was accused of supplying his powerful pals, like Prince Andrew, with young sex slaves in a lawsuit filed last week.

Prince Andrew has denied the accusations.
