



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ISLAND GROUNDS, INC.



THE UNDERSIGNED INCORPORATORS, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Virgin Islands and particularly Title 13 of the Virgin Islands Code, hereby adopt the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation hereby incorporated is Island Grounds, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

The address of the principal place of business of this corporation is 6100 Red Hook Quarter, Suite B-3, American Yacht Harbor, St. Thomas, Virgin Islands 00802. The name of the resident agent of this corporation is Maria Tankenson Hodge, 1340 Taarneberg, Thomas, Virgin Islands.

ARTICLE THREE

Purposes and Powers

Without limiting in any manner the scope and generality of the allowable functions of the corporation, it is hereby provided that the corporation shall have the following purposes and powers:

1. To engage in various ventures, including, without limitation, maintenance, repair, upkeep and general dealings with property, and related services, in the U.S. Virgin Islands.
2. To operate trade and deal in business ventures, goods, wares, and merchandise, and real and personal property of every kind, whether located within the Virgin Islands or elsewhere, and to otherwise conduct business.
3. To enter into partnerships, whether general or limited.
4. To enter into and carry out any contracts for or in relation to the foregoing business with any person, firm, association, corporation, or government or governmental agency.
5. To adopt, apply for, obtain, register, purchase, lease, take licenses in respect of or otherwise acquire, and to maintain, protect, hold, use, own, exercise, develop, manufacture under, operate and introduce, and to sell and grant licenses and other rights in respect of, assign or otherwise dispose of, turn to account, or in any manner deal with and contract with reference to, any trademarks, trade tent rights, concessions, franchises, designs, copyrights and

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~~distinctive marks and right analogous thereto, and inventions, devices, processes, recipes, formulae and improvements and modifications thereof.~~

6. To borrow or raise money to any amount permitted by law by the sale or issue of bonds, notes, debentures, or other obligations of any kind and to secure the same by mortgages or other liens upon any and all of the property of every kind of the corporation.
7. To do all and everything necessary, suitable, and proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or the attainment of any of the objectives or the exercise of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in connection with other firms, individuals, associations, or corporations in the Virgin Islands and elsewhere, and to do any other acts or things incidental to the said business, purposes, objects, and powers or any part thereof not inconsistent with the laws of the Virgin Islands, and to exercise any and all powers now or hereafter conferred by law on business corporations whether expressly enumerated herein or not.
8. The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers and, except where otherwise expressed, such objects and powers shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clauses in this certificate of incorporation, but the objects and powers so specified shall be regarded as independent objects and powers. It is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation.

ARTICLE FOUR

Minimum Capital

The minimum amount of capital with which this corporation will commence business shall be ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00).

ARTICLE FIVE

Duration

This corporation is to have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE SIX

ARTICLE SEVEN

Directors

The number of directors of this corporation shall be fixed by, or in the manner provided in, the Bylaws, but in no case shall the number be less than three nor more than five.

ARTICLE EIGHT

Capitalization

The total number of shares of stock which this corporation shall have authority to issue is one thousand (1,000) shares of no par value common stock.

ARTICLE NINE

Informal Action

Any action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting if all members of the Board individually or collectively consent in writing to such action. Such written consent or consents shall be filed with the minutes of the proceedings of the Board and shall have the same force and effect as a unanimous vote of the directors.

Whenever the vote of stockholders, at a meeting of stockholders, is required or permitted to be taken in connection with any corporate action, the meeting and vote of stockholders may be dispensed with if all stockholders who would have been entitled to vote on the action, if the meeting were held, consent in writing to the action, except that sale, lease, or exchange of assets may be approved by the written consent of the holders of a majority of the voting stock issued and outstanding as provided in 13 V.I.C. Section 281.

ARTICLE TEN

Bylaws

The original bylaws for the management of the affairs of this corporation may be adopted by the incorporators. Thereafter the board of directors shall have the authority to make and to adopt bylaws, subject to the right of a majority of the stockholders to amend, repeal, alter, or modify such bylaws at any regular meeting, or at any special meeting called for such purpose.

CONSENT of AGENT for SERVICE of PROCESS

This writing witnesseth that the undersigned MARIA TANKENSON HODGE having been designated by the corporation known as:

ISLAND GROUNDS, INC.

as agent of the said corporation upon whom service of process may be made in all suits arising against the said corporation in the Courts of the Virgin Islands, does hereby consent to act as such agent, and that service of process may be made upon me in accordance with Title 13 of the Virgin Islands Code.
