Details: 10/11/2006 [REDACTED] was interviewed pursuant to a federal investigation regarding the sexual exploitation of minors. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing agent, [REDACTED] provided the following information: [REDACTED] was contacted by [REDACTED], Jeffrey Epstein's personal assistant, to arrange massage appointments for Epstein. [REDACTED] would call [REDACTED] cellular telephone from New York and state she and Epstein were traveling to Palm Beach, was [REDACTED] available to work. [REDACTED] explained that work meant providing Epstein massages and which included sexual activity. Additionally, [REDACTED] would call [REDACTED] cellular telephone and state she and Epstein are in town, was [REDACTED] available to work. Occasionally, [REDACTED] would call on behalf of [REDACTED] or Epstein and arrange appointments. [REDACTED] would usually call from the Epstein residence in Palm Beach. During her frequent visits to the Epstein residence, Epstein was well aware of her age. At one point, Epstein asked how old she was and she replied seventeen, but getting close to eighteen. Before [REDACTED] turned eighteen, Epstein wished her a happy eighteenth birthday pending the actual day. For [REDACTED] eighteenth birthday, Epstein provided [REDACTED] with two or three sets of Victoria Secret underwear and bras. Furthermore, during their relationship, Epstein, purchased [REDACTED] a new Olympic digital camera and photography book. [REDACTED] stated her and Epstein had sexual intercourse on one occasion, when she was seventeen. On frequent occasions, [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. At one point, prior to [REDACTED] eighteenth birthday, Epstein invited [REDACTED] to participate in [REDACTED] [REDACTED].
