██████████ advised she worked for JEFREY EPSTEIN on Little Saint James for approximately one and a half weeks. ██████████ was hired as a ██████████. ██████████ began working on LSJ in the beginning of ██████████ and stopped working for him shortly thereafter. ██████████ was advised something came up in her background check that EPSTEIN did not like. EPSTEIN was on the island for a few days when ██████████ was working. ██████████ met EPSTEIN and cooked lunch for him and some female guests. ██████████ advised the female guests did not appear to be minors and they looked Eastern European. ██████████ advised she got a "weird vibe" from EPSTEIN.

██████████ advised the following people may have more information regarding EPSTEIN:

- 1) "██████████" - ██████████ and was the "go-between" for everything. ██████████ worked on LSJ since before the flood. ██████████ believes EPSTEIN paid for ██████████ children's school.
- 2) "CARLOS LNU" - "buyer". ██████████ believes EPSTEIN paid for CARLOS' medical bills.
- 3) "LISTON" - current IT guy on LSJ.

██████████ advised her boyfriend, ██████████ ██████████. ██████████ advised a "friend" of hers who worked on LSJ (██████████ was unwilling to provide any information for the individual) observed a box of computers on the beach one day. A few days later, the box was observed and it was empty.
