██████████, date of birth (DOB) ██████████, was interviewed at ██████████. Present for the interview were her attorneys ██████████, along with ██████████ via telephone conference. Also present for the interview was AUSA ██████████, AUSA ██████████, Detective ██████████, and Special Agent ██████████. After being advised of the identities of the above listed individuals and the nature of the interview, ██████████ provided the following information:

JEFFREY EPSTEIN was the center of ██████████ universe.

██████████ talked about a time where EPSTEIN opened the door to a room and there were multiple assistants. ██████████ met ██████████ who ██████████ felt organized a lot of stuff before ██████████ knew her. In the beginning, ██████████ mostly dealt with EPSTEIN. At one-point ██████████ passport was scanned and they made travel arrangements for her. EPSTEIN demeaned ██████████ in front of ██████████, saying "best little cocksucker", referring to ██████████. The house maid usually opened the door for ██████████.

In approximately January 2005, ██████████ was supposed to go to EPSTEIN's island, but could not go because she had shows. EPSTEIN checked in with her. EPSTEIN told ██████████, "We are going to have ██████████ put you in my schedule."

██████████ recalled that in springtime she was shopping with EPSTEIN and maybe three other girls; they were shopping at "Ralph Lauren". One of the girls was ██████████, who lived in the 66th Street apartment building. ██████████ recalled that the girls seemed like they knew the routine. ██████████ recalled thinking that all of the clothes looked like they were for old people.

██████████ went to a ██████████ concert with EPSTEIN. There were other people who went as well but ██████████ did not recall who all went.

[REDACTED] described a lot of EPSTEIN's assistants being very pretty. EPSTEIN said that they all look expensive. [REDACTED] would call [REDACTED] to schedule appointments. EPSTEIN and [REDACTED] both contacted [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was EPSTEIN's assistant. [REDACTED] felt that she found [REDACTED] "kind of fake". [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] as an ambitious assistant running around doing everything to make him happy. [REDACTED] thought [REDACTED] saw things and "swallowed it".

A couple months into [REDACTED] knowing EPSTEIN, he became more comfortable. [REDACTED] began seeing [REDACTED]; she would be in the background. When EPSTEIN forced [REDACTED] to "give him head" in the hallway, [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] there. EPSTEIN was violent about forcing [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] pulled away and [REDACTED] came in. [REDACTED] then left. [REDACTED] recalled this was in the hallway and the kitchen was nearby. EPSTEIN was sitting on a cushion. [REDACTED] thought this was downstairs, maybe on the first floor. [REDACTED] walked in and said, "Oh haha". EPSTEIN was bragging about [REDACTED] later. [REDACTED] was so embarrassed. [REDACTED] had something to tell him. [REDACTED] does not recall if [REDACTED] came back but did recall EPSTEIN bragging about [REDACTED]. EPSTEIN said that [REDACTED] was his "best little cocksucker". EPSTEIN said this more than one time. [REDACTED] said, "That's good to know."

EPSTEIN referred to [REDACTED] as "one of his girls" to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] thought this was around the time that he had taken photos of her in her panties.

[REDACTED] described having really short calls and text messages with [REDACTED]. They discussed times to meet and most of the time it was [REDACTED] reaching out to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] never had EPSTEIN's phone number. [REDACTED] was another assistant that [REDACTED] communicated with. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that anytime she wanted to talk with EPSTEIN to call collect. When [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] spoke, [REDACTED] would say something like, "Can you meet at 11 on Tuesday..to give a massage?". This seemed normal to [REDACTED] because this was how she scheduled castings/bookings with her booker.

EPSTEIN had an idea that all the girls were getting new underwear. [REDACTED] ran an errand to Victoria's Secret to get them. They were in the office space with a table and bookcase, couch, and meeting room. [REDACTED] had to try the underwear on in the staircase near the room. [REDACTED] could not recall if this was before or after a massage but thought that maybe she had

just come in. EPSTEIN stated, "This is what we are doing today.". EPSTEIN liked white lingerie, but hated black lingerie. [REDACTED] then recalled that she did not know if it was [REDACTED] or a messenger that went to get the underwear. EPSTEIN gave [REDACTED] instruction to get them, saying, "Get more of those.". It seemed to [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had done this before. EPSTEIN told [REDACTED] to go to "Victoria's Secret". EPSTEIN explained to [REDACTED] what he liked, that he liked white lingerie. EPSTEIN wanted [REDACTED] to put them on; EPSTEIN told her to put them on, like it was an instruction. [REDACTED] did not recall other people being around. EPSTEIN had a camera. [REDACTED] thought that [REDACTED] had given her the underwear. [REDACTED] described it was "kinda like, here it is". [REDACTED] described EPSTEIN as being more comfortable with her; [REDACTED] had stayed at his place. [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] as a power girl; [REDACTED] had this job and seemed to be on point.

[REDACTED] sent [REDACTED] money via Western Union. [REDACTED] wired [REDACTED] money when she was in [REDACTED] planning to go to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had told EPSTEIN that she was not going to spend her summer with him; he seemed very frustrated. EPSTEIN told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] would send her money. EPSTEIN had [REDACTED] send [REDACTED] a return ticket. [REDACTED] sent [REDACTED] an email asking her if she had received the money.

EPSTEIN made [REDACTED] out to be someone to aspire to be. [REDACTED] did not talk with [REDACTED] about her life or background. [REDACTED] was civil to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] could not recall if [REDACTED] had given her money from massages. [REDACTED] felt that [REDACTED] knew what was going on because she scheduled the massages.

[REDACTED] recalled that when she and her sister went to [REDACTED] she wanted to impress her sister. A house manager at EPSTEIN's [REDACTED] apartment scanned their passports. [REDACTED] sister was really freaked out. They did not know why their passports were scanned. There were pictures on the wall of girls on the island.

[REDACTED] had conversations with EPSTEIN about school and Harvard. In the beginning, [REDACTED] told him what she wanted to do. EPSTEIN told her, "Well, I know the President...I can get you a recommendation letter.". EPSTEIN told her, "You'd have to earn grades to get there but I can help you.". EPSTEIN gave [REDACTED] a laptop; it was outdated. EPSTEIN gave this to her after she had massaged him. He went to a table and said, "Here, I don't need this

anymore.". [REDACTED] had her own SAT book; she didn't take a preparatory course.

[REDACTED] recalled [REDACTED] did not do anything work wise in front of her. [REDACTED] knocked on her door to check up on her. EPSTEIN had given her roses and she asked [REDACTED] if she was safe there. [REDACTED] told her, "You're fine, completely safe here.". [REDACTED] described the girls she saw were more outgoing than she herself was.

[REDACTED] described a time where EPSTEIN dangled an event for her to go to then told her that [REDACTED] was going. [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] as maybe [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] as very pretty and she looked like a model. [REDACTED] described [REDACTED] as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] seemed comfortable and outgoing.

[REDACTED] received emails from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] recalled speaking with [REDACTED] once. [REDACTED] sent [REDACTED] tickets when [REDACTED] moved to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told her, "Jeffrey's wondering if you want to go to the island.". [REDACTED] did not start speaking with [REDACTED] until after she moved from New York. [REDACTED] did not recall ever meeting [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was EPSTEIN's assistant. [REDACTED] recalled she [REDACTED] has some emails she exchanged with [REDACTED].

There was a roundtrip ticket booked for [REDACTED]; GHISLAINE MAXWELL's name was either on the ticket as booking it or her account was listed on the ticket. This was when [REDACTED] was supposed to come back to New York. [REDACTED] recalled the tickets were through "Expedia". [REDACTED] had heard MAXWELL's name before recalling that she was possibly a friend of EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] recalled seeing notepads with MAXWELL's name on it. [REDACTED] never met MAXWELL.

[REDACTED] was in an apartment by herself; [REDACTED] did not recall meeting anyone else.

[REDACTED] celebrated her birthdays during [REDACTED]. EPSTEIN called [REDACTED] on her birthday when she was in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] emailed her about her birthday; it was the first time she had been home in three years for her birthday. On [REDACTED] 18th birthday, her mother freaked out on them when they called her.
