[REDACTED] was advised of the identity of the interviewing agent and purpose of the interview. [REDACTED] voluntarily provided the following information: On November 2, 2007, private investigator [REDACTED] and a Hispanic, well dressed female visited [REDACTED] residence. Initially [REDACTED] was asking for "[REDACTED]" and another name [REDACTED] could not recall, before he said [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was working on behalf of attorney's for Jeffrey Epstein.
