[REDACTED], date of birth [REDACTED] on July 14th, 2020, was interviewed by telephone via [REDACTED]. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Task Force Officer and the nature of the interview, [REDACTED] provided the following information:

[REDACTED] stated that during the summer of 1992, she was seventeen (17) years of age and visiting New York City [REDACTED]. While she ([REDACTED]) was in central park she approached a woman walking dogs, in the park. [REDACTED] further stated, she has a passion for dogs and during a conversation with the woman, [REDACTED], was offered a job walking the dogs for Twenty Dollars (\$20.00). [REDACTED], stated the woman in question, GHISLAINE MAXWELL. [REDACTED] stated, to MAXWELL, she was only visiting New York on vacation. [REDACTED] said she exchanged phone numbers with MAXWELL. Within a day or so [REDACTED], headed to the JEFFREY EPSTEIN residence on 71 Street, off of Madison Avenue, Manhattan, for what [REDACTED] believed was a job interview (dog walker). While waiting inside the EPSTEIN residence for the interview to start, MAXWELL offered [REDACTED], a drink (orange juice). [REDACTED] went on to state that after she drank the orange juice, provided by MAXWELL, she felt dizzy and groggy. [REDACTED], stated that at that point EPSTEIN told her ([REDACTED]) to relax and that the "interview" would start soon. [REDACTED] stated a short time later she was helped by MAXWELL and an unknown female housekeeper to a bedroom and placed on a bed. [REDACTED], stated that when she awoke in the said bedroom (unknown length of time), she ([REDACTED]) was experiencing vaginal bleeding and a burning sensation from her vaginal area. [REDACTED],

further stated at that point both MAXWELL and the unknown housekeeper helped her ([REDACTED]) to shower and bath. [REDACTED], also stated that both MAXWELL and the unknown housekeeper stated that she ([REDACTED]) became sick and had to lay down. [REDACTED] stated she received a manila envelope from MAXWELL that contained Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) in addition to the original Twenty Dollars agreed upon.

[REDACTED], further stated she did not tell any of her family of the aforementioned events, as she felt her mother would be angry as in her family's culture (Thai) a woman remains celibate until marriage. [REDACTED] also stated she provided her friends limited information of the encounter with Epstein and MAXWELL. [REDACTED] went on to inform the author, approximately eight months after the aforementioned events she had a doctors visit to receive a hepatitis shot, yet was nervous and embarrassed to mention her first sexual experience to her doctor. [REDACTED] also stated none of the aforementioned events were reported to law enforcement, out of fear and embarrassment.

The author felt that [REDACTED] was being truthful and expressed candor as well as verbally distressed and sounded to have been traumatized. [REDACTED], further indicated that she has been seeking therapy in [REDACTED] area to deal with the aforementioned events documented in this report. [REDACTED] currently resides at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED], was offered victim services, indicating she would be receptive. The author conferred with FBI VS [REDACTED], providing the contact information for [REDACTED]. VS [REDACTED] stated she will endeavor to contact [REDACTED] and arrange for any available services requested via a counterpart in the [REDACTED] Field Office.
