[REDACTED] recalls that she first met GHISLAINE MAXWELL in September of 1997. She recalls this date because it was a year after she had left the university but it was prior to her birthday. [REDACTED]

This friend knew MAXWELL. [REDACTED] goes to MAXWELL's house in Belgravia and meets MAXWELL for the first time. MAXWELL was nice and asked many questions. She asked [REDACTED] about herself and what she wanted to do with her future. At the time MAXWELL was having a party and everyone there seemed to be nice and happy. [REDACTED] knew some of the people there so she felt comfortable.

After about a week [REDACTED] MAXWELL's boyfriend (JEFFREY EPSTEIN) shows up in [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] meets him. Together they made her feel comfortable and welcome. MAXWELL was smart and witty and EPSTEIN was friendly and kind. On this first instance they met in the office and everything went fine. [REDACTED] recalls that EPSTEIN put his foot in her lap. It had seemed odd but MAXWELL laughed. MAXWELL may have said something about rubbing his foot. It was strange but [REDACTED] did it. [REDACTED] EPSTEIN asked her lots of questions. MAXWELL and EPSTEIN seemed close. [REDACTED] felt like she trusted them. [REDACTED] knew that EPSTEIN was someone important but at the time wasn't totally sure why. She knew he had lots of homes and employees. [REDACTED] Afterwards, [REDACTED] ran errands.

The pilots also seemed nice. [REDACTED] felt safe and excited.

[REDACTED] does not recall a strict timeline on when she moved to New York [REDACTED] Prior to moving to New York she recalls seeing EPSTEIN a few more times in [REDACTED] On the third occasion MAXWELL leaves the office and tells [REDACTED] that she doesn't have to come until the next day because EPSTEIN was leaving. EPSTEIN tells [REDACTED] that he has to take a rest and he tells her to come to the room. While in there he asks her to rub his foot. Then there was a very unexpected incident that occurred. At this point in the interview, it was very upsetting to [REDACTED] and she wished to not talk further on this incident.

Afterwards [REDACTED] goes home. [REDACTED] wanted to go to America but was afraid that MAXWELL would be mad at her over what had happened with EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] may have called a friend to discuss what happened. [REDACTED] goes in the office to tell MAXWELL what EPSTEIN had done. [REDACTED] had to build up the courage to do this. After she tells MAXWELL what

happened, [REDACTED] feels dumb as though she "made a mountain out of a mole hill". MAXWELL made it feel as though it wasn't a big deal. She made [REDACTED] feel like a fool, like she shouldn't have said anything and like it's not important. MAXWELL flipped it and made her feel like she was lucky and that somehow [REDACTED] was special.

Prior to moving to New York, [REDACTED] learned to drive in one week. It was very stressful [REDACTED] failed the first time taking the test and MAXWELL tells her it's ok and to try again. [REDACTED] takes it again and she passes. That afternoon, prior to taking the test, a flight had already been booked.

Prior to leaving [REDACTED], [REDACTED] takes a trip on [REDACTED] with MAXWELL to meet [REDACTED] mother and father. Both of [REDACTED] parents loved MAXWELL as she was charming, funny and likeable. [REDACTED] They all laugh at this comment. They all felt safe and MAXWELL told [REDACTED] parents that she was going to look after their daughter.

[REDACTED] was really trusting back then and was taught to respect her elders.

When [REDACTED] eventually moves to the United States she first travels to Palm Beach where she stays for about three days before she moves to New York. When in New York, she is shown what will be her apartment/ studio. This apartment was provided to [REDACTED] and would be docked out of her pay. MAXWELL shows [REDACTED] a map of Manhattan and points out where everyone lives and where the office is located. MAXWELL felt motherly and [REDACTED] felt she cared for her. The office is where they run their properties. [REDACTED] in MAXWELL's office.

[REDACTED] recalls that her apartment was [REDACTED] The office was on 51 Street. MAXWELL's flat was on 84 Street. EPSTEIN's house was on 71 Street.

[REDACTED] helped MAXWELL to clear through her closet and clear and organize her house. She also assisted in helping with her house design, decorating and running errands. [REDACTED] She would document antiques that were sold or bought.

[REDACTED] started making friends and going out [REDACTED]

Everything [REDACTED] was on a need-to-know basis. There was always a never ending list of things to do and it was very overwhelming. Over time, things changed a lot. Things got bigger...the planes, the houses. It was constant work. At first, [REDACTED] had felt like part of a family. She felt accepted and felt like they cared.

[REDACTED] They traveled often and [REDACTED] felt lucky. The travel started right away. Sometimes, [REDACTED] would travel with them but not actually stay with MAXWELL and EPSTEIN. Sometimes when they went to Florida [REDACTED] would go and stay with her boyfriend. If she went to the island or to the ranch then she definitely would stay with them.

When [REDACTED] went to England or Palm Beach she would sometimes visit with family or friends while there. [REDACTED] learned to stop asking questions because they would get annoyed. MAXWELL would give her that sense.

[REDACTED] states that her friend [REDACTED] said that he trusted these people as well so they both felt difficulties processing what all has been unfolding. They (EPSTEIN and MAXWELL) are "people you admire so it's difficult to comprehend that they would do these things".

[REDACTED] knew [REDACTED] from back then. [REDACTED] walked into a flat to check on it. She would make sure that everything was neat and working and that it was stocked with groceries. [REDACTED] went to change the kettle and [REDACTED] was there in his boxers. [REDACTED] was shocked. They ended up chatting and hanging out. In or around [REDACTED] went to a concert with [REDACTED]. They talked about how difficult it was for [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] thinks that [REDACTED] might be part of this case. It makes [REDACTED] angry with MAXWELL and EPSTEIN because [REDACTED] family are a sweet family.

[REDACTED] met them in [REDACTED] on one occasion and in [REDACTED] last year when [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] then noticed that MAXWELL was not happy and she would take it out on her. Their relationship changed a lot. More people started coming around all the time. It became less friendly between MAXWELL and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did not feel valued. In New York it was more intense. On the Island [REDACTED] did not want to be there.

In 2001, [REDACTED] they were being mean and [REDACTED] felt like she was getting pushed out. She felt trapped and didn't know where to go. It was getting toxic and there were lots of arguments. One example of this that [REDACTED] recalls is that one day she was [REDACTED] feeling sad and depressed when MAXWELL looked at her and says "I don't want to look at you just go home".

[REDACTED] didn't see them together that much, maybe in Palm Beach. MAXWELL and EPSTEIN would fight and argue. Then MAXWELL would be in a bad mood. Sometimes EPSTEIN would yell at [REDACTED]. This happened more often [REDACTED] [REDACTED] met [REDACTED] around that time and she often traveled with him and not with MAXWELL and EPSTEIN. Lots of staff left around this time. It was a toxic environment and didn't feel like a family anymore.

A couple at the ranch left.

[REDACTED] best friend [REDACTED] in New York left. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was told she could not call her anymore and she was scared to contact her. It seemed ridiculous that she could not contact her friend but she had signed a non-disclosure.

[REDACTED] sister, who worked at the ranch, also left.

From the start, [REDACTED] believed that EPSTEIN and MAXWELL were boyfriend and girlfriend. [REDACTED] was told from the start that wealthy men that aren't married don't have to settle down with one person. EPSTEIN had girlfriends and [REDACTED] accepted that. [REDACTED] did not know who was just a friend and who was a girlfriend.

[REDACTED] thought that MAXWELL just really wanted to marry him. She seemed

like a lost soul and it seemed like she wanted to just settle down and have kids. By the time [REDACTED] left it seemed as though they were drifting apart. MAXWELL did not seem as important. There seemed to be another girlfriend. MAXWELL moved into 65th street. MAXWELL was very upset and crying about another girlfriend that came back. [REDACTED] was a shoulder for her to cry on and she felt sorry for her.

Not too long before [REDACTED] left they asked her if she would carry a baby for them. [REDACTED] later read that in the news that they did this to someone else. Near the end, EPSTEIN said he wanted to get a house for [REDACTED]. He would drive her around and give her attention. [REDACTED] couldn't get a house because she didn't make enough money.

In the office, if EPSTEIN came in [REDACTED] had to get his tea and muffins ready for when he sat down. [REDACTED] was nervous that she wouldn't have it ready in time and possibly get in trouble.

On one occasion she got called into his room in Palm Beach. EPSTEIN and MAXWELL were both there and they were excited. There was a bump in the bed. One of them told her to sit down and see what the bump is. [REDACTED] pulled back the sheet and there was a violin case. They had previously known that [REDACTED] played violin. Inside the case was a violin. They tell her to go play it. [REDACTED] started playing it but a string broke. [REDACTED] ran out of the room, states it felt strange. She was not sure what was happening and not sure why it was given to her in bed. Around 2011, [REDACTED] sells the violin.

The first incident in [REDACTED] with EPSTEIN was the first time "it happened" but it happened more sporadically. [REDACTED] felt she needed to tell MAXWELL because it was sexual. The other incidents were also sometimes sexual.

There were other times that there were others involved in the sexual encounters other than EPSTEIN. MAXWELL was involved about 1-2 times. There were about 4-5 other people involved over the years. There were never males involved. The places it happened in was New York, Palm Beach, New Mexico, The Virgin Islands and on the plane. In New York it only happened after [REDACTED] and she would be caught off guard when it happened. On the plane it happened once on their way to Harvard. Sometimes

on the plane [REDACTED] would serve meals but she generally just rubbed EPSTEIN's feet.

It would get put in [REDACTED] head that she was great at foot massages. She gave foot massages to MAXWELL sometimes. In the beginning that's how it all started, with foot massages. [REDACTED] massaged EPSTEIN's hands when they were at the movies a lot.

[REDACTED] had her photo taken on the beach on the island by the rocks by MAXWELL. The photo session was meant to just be this fun thing with no real purpose. MAXWELL told her this. Other people on the island were there for this. [REDACTED] just did what she was told and it felt a bit like peer pressure. The photos that were taken on the rocks [REDACTED] was not wearing clothes. No one was wearing clothes. [REDACTED] felt like she had to. She thinks she has seen these photos since.

Sometimes [REDACTED] would get a towel and lotion and do a massage properly. [REDACTED] and EPSTEIN would talk during these times. [REDACTED] would never know if these massages would lead into something else or not.

There was not necessarily a pattern because it was different in each place they traveled. Sometimes EPSTEIN would say "see you upstairs". Sometimes [REDACTED] would massage his feet and he would fall asleep. Sometimes it would lead to something else.

[REDACTED] never had intercourse with EPSTEIN. It was a rule that MAXWELL told [REDACTED]. MAXWELL said that she was the only one that sleeps in his bed. MAXWELL said, "I'm the girlfriend and I'm the one that gets to sleep with him." At the time, [REDACTED] just thought this was what was expected of her. He reduced her to accept this as her job. [REDACTED] thought she wasn't worth more.

[Agent note: At this point in the interview a break was taken and Detective Byrne stepped out of the room and was no longer present during the following portion of the interview.]

[REDACTED] described herself as a girl who is shy and closes the curtain in the changing room.

At the time of the photograph incident, [REDACTED] was not comfortable with

it, but felt like she would get in trouble if she said no. [REDACTED] felt empty and it did not feel right. [REDACTED] would not have chosen to do something like that. MAXWELL was quite flippant saying something like, "Oh, no one's going to see your face; you'll blend into the rocks." [REDACTED] could not say no; she was on an island with no where to go and [REDACTED] was telling her to do something.

Another time photographs were taken it was just [REDACTED] and EPSTEIN. EPSTEIN took out a camera and said "take your top off". [REDACTED] did not want to do that. EPSTEIN pushed her (not physically) to do something [REDACTED] did not want to do. EPSTEIN took a photograph of [REDACTED] without her top on. [REDACTED] wondered why he was making her feel that way. [REDACTED] felt disappointment that she did not matter. [REDACTED] felt that EPSTEIN and MAXWELL were kind generous people but she was scared of them as well.

MAXWELL referred to [REDACTED] as her "little sister". MAXWELL also referred to [REDACTED] in derogatory terms but would say that it was all in jest. MAXWELL and EPSTEIN were cruel.

[REDACTED] remembered the incident with the violin and remembered it being really dark. [REDACTED] could not remember everything in the specific sequence it happened. [REDACTED] thought "it happened" one to two times maximum. MAXWELL left her alone after that. [REDACTED] thought it was after it happened that MAXWELL stroked [REDACTED] arm saying, "You have such soft skin." [REDACTED] thought MAXWELL thought she went over the line because of how [REDACTED] reacted. [REDACTED] could not remember if MAXWELL was nude.

MAXWELL was not ashamed of her body. MAXWELL would strip one thing off and change into something else. [REDACTED] would turn her back.

That was when their relationship started to go sour because [REDACTED] would not go along with it.

A separate incident from the violin incident was a time where MAXWELL was sitting on the left side opposite [REDACTED] while EPSTEIN was to the right of [REDACTED]. EPSTEIN was on the right hand side where his gun was. MAXWELL was topless. [REDACTED] thought MAXWELL grabbed her arm and put it on MAXWELL's chest. [REDACTED] was in a situation she did not want to be in [REDACTED] [REDACTED] did not ask for it nor did she want it. [REDACTED] did not find MAXWELL attractive and felt sick. It felt like it was an out of body

experience for [REDACTED]; she was extremely uncomfortable and unhappy about the situation. It was a situation that should not have happened. It involved the removal of clothes. They never spoke of it again [REDACTED] people don't talk about issues that are difficult. [REDACTED] felt an excuse to leave really fast.

[REDACTED] never had intercourse with EPSTEIN and never had "anything major" with a woman.

[REDACTED] had similar experiences with friends of hers she met through EPSTEIN and MAXWELL. Nothing sort of major happened. The stuff [REDACTED] has read about that is pornographic did not happen to her. [REDACTED]

The incidents with [REDACTED] peers were where they were all older than her. [REDACTED] felt the whole world knows these things and felt stuck in a nightmare.

[REDACTED] talked about a really upsetting time when she was invited on a trip to the island. At the time, [REDACTED] was living in [REDACTED]. There was a science convention being held on the island. [REDACTED] was initially excited about it; [REDACTED]. When [REDACTED] arrived there were four or five other women there that she had not met before. [REDACTED] was shown to a room with three other people and felt it was strange. At one point someone came to take [REDACTED] to EPSTEIN and she followed. One person grabbed EPSTEIN's foot, while another grabbed an arm, and another a hand. [REDACTED] was rubbing EPSTEIN's foot. [Agent note: [REDACTED] attorney [REDACTED] interjected saying that EPSTEIN was pleasuring himself or the others were pleasuring him during this incident. [REDACTED] concurred with this statement.] [REDACTED] was dumbfounded that she was put in this situation - she did not see it coming. [REDACTED] was really angry. [REDACTED] did not remember the rest of the trip. [REDACTED] had thought she was being asked there as a special guest but she felt she was just being used.

[REDACTED] When [REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] her school fees were paid for the first year. MAXWELL still came into town occasionally. MAXWELL wanted to meet [REDACTED] friends; she always wanted to meet everyone in her life. MAXWELL would want a massage therapist or a yoga instructor when she came into town. There was one dinner where [REDACTED] showed up to and realized MAXWELL was up to something. This was in [REDACTED] and BILL CLINTON arrived. [REDACTED] felt it was a lovely dinner and it was the first and only time she met CLINTON. When [REDACTED] was in [REDACTED] MAXWELL was very pushy and [REDACTED] was fearful of her. [REDACTED] felt that MAXWELL had changed.

[REDACTED] recalled sitting opposite of one of them and felt that something was different, like their soul wasn't there anymore. [REDACTED] felt it was difficult to explain. It was also conflicting for [REDACTED] at the same time as she also still felt a fondness for MAXWELL.

[REDACTED] met PRINCE ANDREW a few times; there were no strange experiences with him. [REDACTED] felt she did not know what to believe anymore. [REDACTED] saw PRINCE ANDREW in Palm Beach. EPSTEIN told [REDACTED] to take PRINCE ANDREW to a bar in Miami. [REDACTED] went there with another friend and everything was fine. What [REDACTED] has read about him and what her experience with him was different.

Around the end of 2007/2008 [REDACTED] friend asked, "Oh have you heard about Jeffrey". When [REDACTED] responded no, her friend told her EPSTEIN was in trouble. [REDACTED] just thought someone was after his money. [REDACTED] thought he was in jail for about a year and a half. [REDACTED] thought EPSTEIN had done something he wasn't supposed to do; someone had told her that someone had accused EPSTEIN of something. Next thing [REDACTED] heard was that some women were talking about investigation taking place. [REDACTED] remembered thinking "oh my God there are these really young girls". [REDACTED] was upset because she knew EPSTEIN and MAXWELL.

[REDACTED] would have seen MAXWELL before EPSTEIN went to jail but she did not recall speaking to MAXWELL about it.

In or around August 2019, [REDACTED] had read about the recent investigation. [REDACTED] read about "these girls" and was upset about it as she was reading it along with the rest of the world. When [REDACTED] saw the case was regarding child sex trafficking she thought it was fake news because her experience was different.

In or around February 2008 was the last time [REDACTED] saw EPSTEIN and it was horrendous.

[Agent note: Interview concluded for 10/14/20.]

(10/15/2020)

Present at the start of the interview day 2 was Assistant United States Attorney [REDACTED], Detective [REDACTED] and Special Agent [REDACTED]. Also present was [REDACTED] attorney [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] states that she was not sure about EPSTEIN's and MAXWELL's financial relationship. MAXWELL was getting a salary of some kind. She may have done things separately, maybe the stock market but [REDACTED] was not totally sure.

JOHN and MARY were the housekeepers in Palm Beach. They were a kind and sweet couple. Each house had a couple that looked after it. MARY would clean, but JOHN would also. JOHN also served drinks and would sometimes drive. He cooked a bit and made breakfast, and did maintenance.

EPSTEIN did not have a personal assistant until later when [REDACTED] replaced her. EPSTEIN had people in the office and in each home that helped a lot.

[REDACTED] She was really nice. [REDACTED] showed her around the different homes but they didn't cross over that much. [REDACTED]

The office would schedule appointments. Each home had staff which would take over when EPSTEIN arrived. [REDACTED] was told to treat him like a king. [REDACTED] didn't know what everyone was doing at all times.

EPSTEIN and MAXWELL both received regular massages. [REDACTED] heard that EPSTEIN would have multiple a day. [REDACTED] was aware that he would get the massages but she also read that he did. He would get massages at all of his properties. They would arrive at some point during the trip. [REDACTED] was probably asked to call someone at some point. [REDACTED] was aware that there would sometimes be a couple massages a day. The massages were important to him; EPSTEIN would say they were therapeutic and they helped him think.

In Palm Beach, [REDACTED] thought maybe JOHN or MARY would call someone to come in for massages. When [REDACTED] was in Palm Beach she would fly in with them and then often go to see her boyfriend.

"The Book", which was an address book, is how they scheduled massages. The book is the one that's all over the Internet now. The Book was there the whole time that [REDACTED] worked there. There was a black book for EPSTEIN and a blue book for MAXWELL. They may have used each book. [REDACTED] sometimes put information into the book. It was an annoying thing and had to be updated regularly. Sometimes she was told to update it. Other people had access to it and updated the book.

[REDACTED] was asked about people in the book coming to give massages. She states that she just was told to put the names and addresses in the book. She said she was asked to call someone from the book. She had called a friend to chat. [REDACTED] had only called to schedule massages a few times. She would be told to call someone to come for a massage.

At the Palm Beach house when someone would show up to give a massage they would let themselves in. They would go upstairs to the massage room and maybe be there for about an hour. Afterwards towels would be brought down and put into the washing machine by the massage therapist. JOHN paid them by writing a check or giving cash. Then they would go home. Sometimes the cash came from petty cash. What [REDACTED] observed was girls her age or older giving massages. One girl flew over from California.

[REDACTED] was asked if it was always just one person coming for the massage to which she stated yes. [REDACTED] stated that she later found out that a friend's sister had come over.

[REDACTED] In reference to the book [REDACTED] would have said "this is the book with all of EPSTEIN's contacts and he sometimes gets massages". [REDACTED] was more focused on the home design. [REDACTED] stated that she did recognize the book that she saw online. She recognized it because she has seen it [REDACTED] it's definitely real. The book has grown since she's seen it and the massage list has grown a lot.

MAXWELL had asked [REDACTED] if she wanted to be training in massage therapy to which she stated no.

[REDACTED] thinks that JOHN and MARY were still working there when she left.

[REDACTED] recalled [REDACTED] working there [REDACTED] was working as a receptionist. [REDACTED] sometimes stepped in for her in the New York office. She would answer phones and also worked for EPSTEIN's company. She was a financial advisor for "Epstein and Company".

EPSTEIN was interested in very wealthy and important people's money that only earned over a certain amount. MAXWELL said something about this but EPSTEIN told [REDACTED] the specific amount of money he dealt with.



[REDACTED] recalled going to the office and remembered EPSTEIN sitting there playing with a flip knife the whole time. [REDACTED] did not remember what was said but that was all she could see. This was the last time [REDACTED] saw EPSTEIN; this was her last memory of him.

[REDACTED] thought [REDACTED] was actually taking over for MAXWELL's position, which meant she was running EPSTEIN's homes and had the responsibility of taking care of EPSTEIN.

After [REDACTED] left, MAXWELL became a lot more pushy. MAXWELL went to [REDACTED] and needed help. [REDACTED] felt that MAXWELL had conditioned her to drop everything when MAXWELL needed her. MAXWELL wanted a fitness instructor or yoga therapist. MAXWELL wanted to meet her friends and kept pushing her way into [REDACTED] life. MAXWELL would tell [REDACTED], "Oh Jeffrey's coming into town, can you fill his fridge with groceries?". It was always something. [REDACTED] felt that MAXWELL was trying to keep tabs on

her. It was not friendly anymore; it was kind of depressive.

While [REDACTED] was working for MAXWELL, there were approximately three times where other people were in the room when sexual incidents occurred. [REDACTED] recalled there being a a time where a group was watching TV. [REDACTED] recalled three others, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED]. Those are the only three she could remember as fact. There were various people around. These were people that [REDACTED] hung out with; they were her peers and [REDACTED] thought it would stay between them. Everyone wanted to be there. [REDACTED] was having her school fees paid for so [REDACTED] did not know if she was a victim. [REDACTED] did not want the sexual episode to be happening. [REDACTED] followed what other people did. [REDACTED] described herself as a follower, not a leader.

[REDACTED] was one of [REDACTED] friends in New York. They would go out at night with a group of friends. [REDACTED] really liked [REDACTED] [REDACTED] thought EPSTEIN said he met [REDACTED] while walking on the beach one day. [REDACTED] thought she met [REDACTED] early on. They hung out together and [REDACTED] went to his island. [REDACTED] thought [REDACTED] was presently married. [REDACTED] described EPSTEIN as an intelligent and wealthy man who was attractive to a lot of people.

[REDACTED] was someone who was educated in [REDACTED] She went to EPSTEIN's island a lot and was on his plane quite a few times.

Later, the sexual encounters became more. This was when [REDACTED] was working for MAXWELL. The encounters were more visual and it was more of [REDACTED] just being there. It was more tame than what [REDACTED] has read in the papers and documents. [REDACTED] described the encounters including EPSTEIN pleasuring himself while looking at them and/or one person would take over and be the leader in helping EPSTEIN by touching him.

When [REDACTED] was asked if MAXWELL was in the room during these encounters, she replied no. When [REDACTED] was asked if MAXWELL knew this was happening, she replied yes. [REDACTED] stated she was assuming MAXWELL knew. [REDACTED] suspected MAXWELL had similar "episodes" with other people like she had with [REDACTED]. MAXWELL was on the island with [REDACTED] peers. MAXWELL was "just there"; [REDACTED] did not know what MAXWELL was doing. At the time, [REDACTED] was an acquaintance. [REDACTED] felt that MAXWELL kind of let it happen.

When [REDACTED] was asked if MAXWELL ever made sexual comments about EPSTEIN, she replied that MAXWELL probably did but she could not recall anything specific. MAXWELL made flippant comments or would say something in jest but [REDACTED] could not remember anything specific.

The sexual episodes with a group happened in the island and in New York. The sexual episodes with EPSTEIN and MAXWELL happened in Palm Beach; this was the violin incident and the separate incident.

[REDACTED] thought everyone knew EPSTEIN loved to be surrounded by people. [REDACTED] did not know who was a girlfriend and who was not. When [REDACTED] was asked if there were a lot of young and attractive females around, she replied yes there was. [REDACTED] also said EPSTEIN had unattractive people around. EPSTEIN liked to have an entourage of people. EPSTEIN got mad at [REDACTED] once when he was in the house by himself.

This interview is the first time [REDACTED] has talked in detail about her sexual encounters with EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] also told her therapist at the end of 2015/early 2016.

When [REDACTED] first told MAXWELL after the first sexual episode with EPSTEIN, MAXWELL would clearly have seen she was distress by it. [REDACTED] was distraught; she had not slept. [REDACTED] felt the episode came out of left field. When [REDACTED] was asked if she conveyed that she did not want it to happen, she replied "of course". [REDACTED] did not recall what she said to MAXWELL. [REDACTED] was confused and in shock. After that conversation, it was never spoken of again.

When [REDACTED] was asked if [REDACTED] was ever in the room during a sexual encounter, she replied "no, absolutely not". [REDACTED] was younger than [REDACTED] and they were not in a situation like that.

When [REDACTED] was asked if [REDACTED] was in the room during a sexual encounter, she replied "no". [REDACTED] rubbed EPSTEIN's hands and feet with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised she would admit if she did something wrong, but she did not think she did anything wrong.

[Agent note: At this point in the interview Detective [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stepped back in the room and were present during the following portion of the interview.]

[REDACTED] recalled [REDACTED] being on the plane and the island a lot.

[REDACTED] was someone who stayed in the flat.

[REDACTED], who was in her friendship group, knows different things than [REDACTED]. This friend has expressed an interest in the past of helping in some way.

MAXWELL definitely would have known about the sexual encounters but it was not something that would have been discussed. MAXWELL would say to treat EPSTEIN like a king and do whatever he says. [REDACTED] was made to feel nervous and scared of EPSTEIN.

[REDACTED] was really paranoid about there being a camera in her flat. [REDACTED] felt there may have been a camera in the bathroom; there was a cabinet that [REDACTED] could never pull open. There was also a hole in the wall when she would walk in.

[REDACTED] was really frustrated and wanted to leave. [REDACTED] wanted to leave but felt she could not leave. MAXWELL turned around and whatever name she called [REDACTED] that day said, "Do you want a computer?" This added to [REDACTED] paranoia of always being watched. [REDACTED] felt there was "long time psychological stuff" that occurred.

[REDACTED] recalled a time where she served at a party in [REDACTED] at MAXWELL's house. One of MAXWELL's friends came onto [REDACTED] and MAXWELL went up to him and defended her. [REDACTED] felt protected. In hindsight, [REDACTED] sees that there was a lot of psychological games but there was also kindness.
