The Miami Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) requests the assistance of the ██████████ in delivering a Victim Notification Letter and brochure to ██████████ date of birth ██████████ who has been contacted in the past at ██████████. On 24 July 2006, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Palm Beach Resident Agency (PBCRA) opened an investigation involving the illegal sexual activity between multi-millionaire Jeffrey Epstein and minor aged children. At the conclusion of the sexual activity, the minors were paid sums of money ranging from \$200.00-\$1,000.00. Testimony from multiple witnesses indicate that ██████████, a minor at the time, was one of Jeffrey Epstein's victims. Mr. Epstein is believed to have had contact with ██████████ during the years of 1998/99 - 2003/04. ██████████ is a ██████████ citizen. Under United States Code Title 18 Section 3771, a victim of a crime in the United States has a number of rights which are detailed in the enclosed letter and brochures.
