This morning, AUSA [REDACTED] spoke with Palm Beach Police Department Captain [REDACTED]. The bulk of the conversation focused on identifying contact information for current and former PBPB personnel who were present for the October 2005 search of Jeffrey Epstein's Palm Beach residence.

At the end of the conversation, AUSA [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if he could provide any background regarding [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who conducted the inventory of the October 2005 search. In response, [REDACTED] indicated that [REDACTED] was arrested in or around [REDACTED] by the PBPB for stealing money from PBPB's evidence. According to [REDACTED] was cutting open evidence bags, taking money out of the bags, and resealing the bags. As far as [REDACTED] knows, there was no evidence that [REDACTED] was tampering with evidence other than money. Because there was no money seized from Epstein's residence, there is no reason to believe that [REDACTED] tampered with any evidence seized from the Epstein search.
