**Synopsis:** (U) To document call with journalist Caroline Compton.

**Details:**

On 29 November 2019, [REDACTED] received a telephone call from Caroline Compton, telephone number [REDACTED], email address [REDACTED]. The following are the details of the conversation:

COMPTON provided information about an individual named [REDACTED] of [REDACTED]. COMPTON said she obtained the flight manifests of Jeffery Epstein and [REDACTED] name was on the list. COMPTON asked if the FBI was going to interview [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised that this information would be shared with the FBI case agents and they would

decided if they are going to interview [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised we do not comment on any open investigations. [REDACTED] asked how COMPTON obtained the manifest list. COMPTON said she was a journalist looking into this matter. COMPTON mentioned the FBI would like to interview anyone who was on the plane with EPSTEIN. I asked why she thought the FBI would like to interview anyone on the plane with EPSTEIN. COMPTON sourced her information on an article from New York. [REDACTED] advised COMPTON that the FBI may or may not interview [REDACTED].

On 29 November 2019, [REDACTED] received a second call from COMPTON approximately 30 minutes after the first call. COMPTON claimed she needed to know if the FBI was going to interview [REDACTED] by the end of the day. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that the FBI does not have a deadline to meet. I asked why she had a deadline for tonight? COMPTON mentioned her colleague would like to publish an article about [REDACTED] and would like to know if the FBI was going to interview [REDACTED]. I advised COMPTON that the agents of the investigation were most likely on leave due to Thanksgiving break. I told COMPTON to use the New York article as her source of information. I told COMPTON that I do not know if the FBI is going to interview [REDACTED].

On 3 December 2019, [REDACTED] was advised of an email request sent to the United States Embassy in [REDACTED]. A separate journalist was asking if the US Embassy can provide additional details about the investigation. The email quoted an anonymous FBI agent in [REDACTED] [REDACTED] said, "The FBI will be interviewing [REDACTED]." The US Embassy in [REDACTED] told the reporter that the US Embassy does not comment on any open investigations.

(Agent Notes: A search of ██████████ revealed ██████████ ██████████. News articles indicated the FBI wants to interview ██████████. The article claims ██████████ traveled 15 times in 1996 and 1997 with Jeffrey Epstein. Another article titled "that's why the FBI wants to talk to ██████████" and mentioned the details of the travel ██████████ had with Epstein. End of Agent's Notes)
