[REDACTED] called NTOC back because her initial call was disconnected due to a bad connection. [REDACTED] felt she did not get to convey her fears on reporting the DEA Agent and that she could be killed if he finds out she made the report. [REDACTED] wanted it noted that she requested to be called back first before the DEA Agent is spoken to. [REDACTED] said she had a lot more specifics she can provided. [REDACTED] also wanted to go into the FBI office to speak to someone and not have someone come out to her.
