called the FBI National Threat Operations Center (NTOC) to report that Jeffrey Epstein was [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] provided the following information:

Epstein was [REDACTED] in their database records dating as far as 2008. Epstein would frequently bring young females, some which appeared to be underage. The database contains information on some of these females. Of the 30 to 40 females Epstein brought, most appeared to be no older than 20, and most appeared to be Eastern European. About four or five years ago, Epstein would more frequently bring several females on the same day. [REDACTED] believes that Epstein must have at least spent \$50,000. The females would mostly come to get a haircut, coloring, waxing, costing up to \$200 to \$500 per visit.

Former employee, [REDACTED], who currently works at [REDACTED], closely worked on Epstein and the females he brought to the salon.

[REDACTED], another [REDACTED] employee, who works Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday, can provide more information.
