[REDACTED] called me and told me about two clients:

First client:

- Did not provide name, noted that he has not met her yet
- Was 16 years old in [REDACTED]
- Parents allowed her + 17 year old friend to travel from [REDACTED] to NY for a summer, to travel (alone)
- Land in NY, go to a [REDACTED] church, the meet a man there and say they need a place to stay and a job
- Man put her in touch with [REDACTED] with whom they met
- [REDACTED] says she is a coordinator from [REDACTED] who has helped other people to get jobs
- [REDACTED] coordinates a job for them, giving massages for JE
- During massages, JE was aroused, but did not masturbate in front of them
- JE once asked them to perform sexual acts on each other
- They saw pornographic materials in his house, became alarmed, and they went home to [REDACTED]
- Client is willing to cooperate, and is located in the U.S.

Second client:

- Name is [REDACTED]
- Comes to NY in 1997 (approximately [REDACTED] years old) and is modeling, meets GM at a party
- GM sets up a meeting between [REDACTED] GM, and Les Wexner, who wants her to be a VS model
- Photo shoot is set to be at JE's mansion
- GM leads her to JE's room, where JE forcibly rapes her
- [REDACTED] blogged about the incident around the same time
- Located in [REDACTED] willing to be interviewed by videoconference

[REDACTED] is meeting with the first client next week and will circle back, and I told him we would discuss internally about the second client and get back to him.

During the call, I mentioned that we had submitted our opposition papers to defense motions, and, as a courtesy, we wanted to let him know that the materials we submitted included notes of a meeting he had with our office. I explained that this was in connection with a suppression motion, that Lara and Maurene were handling that issue, and that if we had questions down the road they would reach out to interview him in a more formal manner.
