The Government writes to provide you with information regarding [REDACTED]. In particular, below is a verbatim English translation of an excerpt of information that the Ministry of Justice provided to the Government. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Please note that this letter is governed by the July 31, 2020 Protective Order in this case. **In particular, the letter is designated as “confidential” under the Protective Order.**

- [REDACTED] “met Jeffrey Epstein and his partner Ghislaine Maxwell at the age of 16, in the south of France near Saint Tropez. They had made friends and she went to their Parisian apartment on Avenue Foch in 2000. The same year, she left for Miami with the couple[;] 6 months later, she was invited to New York by Ghislaine Maxwell, near the 5th avenue. It was during these 5 days that Epstein touched [REDACTED], who tried in vain to resist him. She remembered in particular that he had penetrated her with a vibrator. She had never met Jean-Luc Brunel.”
