[REDACTED] used to stay with [REDACTED] in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was with [REDACTED] for about a month while she was in [REDACTED]. During that time period

The first time that [REDACTED] learned about JEFFREY EPSTEIN was after [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] and her [REDACTED] were supporting the family at the time. Then, once they moved to [REDACTED] they no longer needed [REDACTED] support or money. It was unclear if EPSTEIN was supporting them. [REDACTED] sister was not giving them money at the time.

[REDACTED] only met EPSTEIN in New York. [REDACTED] called and told [REDACTED] that she was going to the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] needed help getting a dress. [REDACTED] then went to New York and met her at EPSTEIN's mansion. At this point she thought EPSTEIN was a friend of the family and she had an understanding that he supported the arts and students. [REDACTED] was living in [REDACTED] at this time and thought that EPSTEIN was hitting on her. [REDACTED] was 13 years old at the time. EPSTEIN wanted to take [REDACTED] to his bedroom. EPSTEIN had a lot of Victoria's Secret stuff and pictures. [REDACTED] had told [REDACTED] that he was a part owner. [REDACTED] got the feeling that EPSTEIN was looking up her skirt. When they got to EPSTEIN's bedroom, nothing actually happened.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then went dress shopping. [REDACTED] cried because EPSTEIN only gave her \$2000 for a dress. [REDACTED] was devastated that it was only \$2000. [REDACTED] didn't spend much time with EPSTEIN; he seemed busy. [REDACTED] thought that [REDACTED] was living with EPSTEIN at this time.

[REDACTED] described the mansion to be "hotel like". It was as if he bought the whole block and it was very fancy, like a Four Seasons hotel. She recalled a man greeting her at the door.

When [REDACTED] found out that EPSTEIN was a predator she ran to [REDACTED]

house [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had found out initially because [REDACTED] sent her an article about EPSTEIN. When she arrived at [REDACTED] house, she asked her if she was a victim of EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] said yes but did not cry because she said he was the only one who loved her. [REDACTED] explained to her that he was a monster and then [REDACTED] broke down and cried. [REDACTED] thought of EPSTEIN as a father figure and would have starved and died if he wasn't there for her. EPSTEIN still called her for years after the fact. [REDACTED] did not tell [REDACTED] all of the details of the abuse but she talked about where she went and that she met DONALD TRUMP.

[REDACTED] was scared to talk about the abuse because she heard 1-2 girls who talked had disappeared. EPSTEIN may have mentioned this. [REDACTED] said that she hated being in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] always thought that it was [REDACTED] that she hated being with.

[REDACTED] used to talk about GHISLAINE MAXWELL to [REDACTED]. She said she was the person who coordinated everything. [REDACTED] heard of her when she visited New York but was not sure if she ever met her. MAXWELL may have been the one who gave her the money for the dress but [REDACTED] was not sure.

EPSTEIN had a house at INTERLOCHEN. [REDACTED] heard that EPSTEIN had approached [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at the school there. At the time, [REDACTED] knew of MAXWELL being with EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] visited them at INTERLOCHEN approximately one time (this was prior to the [REDACTED]).

[REDACTED] was not sure how [REDACTED] travel was paid. [REDACTED] never interacted with anyone at EPSTEIN's office about travel. [REDACTED] never met any other employees of EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] went on his private jet. [REDACTED] learned this later on. At the time that this was going on, [REDACTED] did not talk to [REDACTED] about her trips with EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] knew while she was in New York that [REDACTED] sometimes stayed at his house and paid for some stuff. When [REDACTED] visited New York she didn't even see [REDACTED] because [REDACTED] would be at EPSTEIN's house staying with him.

[REDACTED] has had more recent conversations with [REDACTED] about what happened but [REDACTED] still does not go into much detail. [REDACTED] said that MAXWELL was like a pimp and she got all of the girls. EPSTEIN wanted [REDACTED] to get involved as well and to get girls to come massage him.

[REDACTED] recalled that at [REDACTED], [REDACTED] seemed empty

and depressed. She looked like she was dead inside and so sad [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] always figured it was [REDACTED] fault. The [REDACTED] was prior to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] thought it was in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was between 14-16 years old and living in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that "he (EPSTEIN) was the only one who took care of us". [REDACTED] only understood what had happened when [REDACTED] explained to her what happened. [REDACTED] believed [REDACTED] was naive and stupid about the situation. [REDACTED] doesn't know if [REDACTED] even knew what was going on. [REDACTED] rarely talked to [REDACTED] so they did not talk about EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] does not recall hearing about EPSTEIN while she was in Florida. She knew of some family friend in [REDACTED] who was helping them out but did not know it was EPSTEIN. Later on, [REDACTED] assumed it was him.

[REDACTED] used to talk about MAXWELL. She would speak of her positively and [REDACTED] seemed to like her. It seemed like MAXWELL was the secretary. [REDACTED] was not sure when she first heard of MAXWELL but [REDACTED] would talk about her a lot in a positive way. [REDACTED] knew at the time that MAXWELL was EPSTEIN's assistant and possible girlfriend. [REDACTED] thought that after she found out about the abuse both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] told her that MAXWELL would organize and recruit the girls. [REDACTED] would say that MAXWELL was always with EPSTEIN and coordinating. Back while it was going on [REDACTED] would only say that MAXWELL was an assistant.

When [REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] house [REDACTED] to confront her about EPSTEIN's abuse, [REDACTED] was living with [REDACTED]. This was many years ago right after EPSTEIN was first arrested. [REDACTED] would say MAXWELL was always recruiting girls and sometimes boys for massages. Anytime someone needed money or to go on trips or anything they would call MAXWELL who would coordinate it.

At [REDACTED] [REDACTED] noticed a change in [REDACTED] demeanor. This continued until about when [REDACTED] [REDACTED] She then became happy and would go out with friends, drink and have fun. She became more outgoing.

After the news of EPSTEIN first came out, [REDACTED] felt [REDACTED] had gone downhill since then. [REDACTED]

When [REDACTED] went to TRUMP's house, she told [REDACTED] that EPSTEIN said "Isn't this a good one?" and TRUMP responded "yes". [REDACTED] learned about this interaction later on.
