██████████ telephone number ██████████, was interviewed telephonically. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent and the nature of the interview, ██████████ provided the following information:

██████████ was more familiar with the name GHISLAINE MAXWELL than the name JEFFREY EPSTEIN. ██████████ recalled the name "GHISLAINE" because it was a "quite unusual name". ██████████ recalled this was a long time ago around the 1990's when ██████████ daughter, ██████████ mentioned her, saying that MAXWELL was being really nice to her. ██████████ had mentioned MAXWELL quite a bit. ██████████ had told ██████████ that MAXWELL had invited her to her home in London. ██████████ was more vulnerable during this time in her life due to something horrendous that happened in their family. ██████████ was preoccupied and took her eye off of ██████████ and regretted that. ██████████ recalled having an alarm bell go off during that time when ██████████ was mentioning MAXWELL but did not recall why she had that feeling. ██████████ recalled asking ██████████ where MAXWELL lived and remembered walking by the residence. ██████████ believed that she may have met MAXWELL one time in the street but did not know for certain. ██████████ stated that ██████████ did not remember MAXWELL meeting ██████████.

██████████ is willing to speak again and answer further questions.
