I'd like to send a reply to [REDACTED] e mail. I don't think ignoring it will make it or her go away and I'd rather deal directly with her even if you don't want to. Below is what I'd like to send

I have spent many hours and days and months and years working and travelling with [REDACTED]. I liked her from the moment we met and enjoyed her company and benefited from all her help and energy and joie de vivre for all the time we worked together. I have stayed in touch with her and been friends with her since she left [REDACTED]. I have seen her many times since then and we were most recently in touch this Christmas. I have always been there for [REDACTED] and have also always said that I would be there for her in anyway at anytime the same way I would a family member knowing that her chosen career [REDACTED] was always going to be difficult and finding good paying jobs always a challenge as I know first hand myself. I have helped her find other jobs and when ever she reached out or we met tried to suggest other opportunities that I thought she might like or things that I thought would be interesting to her. I was thrilled for her when she said she had met the man of her dreams and was going to marry him.

I am very sad to learn how [REDACTED] has felt and reacted to the appalling press onslaught. I was very distressed to see her name attached at all. I am not dressing many of the more shocking and strange things in your letter because some of them I have no knowledge of and others I question and even more I don't comprehend and the whole is very sad to the point that I am also in tears. I have considered myself a friend of [REDACTED] for almost [REDACTED] and I still consider myself a friend of [REDACTED]. I note you say you don't want her talking to me however I feel that any advice, or help or counsel is best given either to her [REDACTED] and whom for sure have [REDACTED] best interests at heart and whom I trust to guide me if something is needed or wanted from me. I cannot speak for Jeffrey as [REDACTED] knows I have not been with him for many years and think that should you wish to communicate with him you should do so separately from me.

Please, give [REDACTED] my Love and please tell her I would like to talk to her or come and see her or talk [REDACTED] if that would be helpful in some way.
